Overview:

The parties to a technology transaction - whether it is a license agreement or a contract for the purchase/sale of items - understandably focus on price, date of delivery, and identification of the deliverables. However, should a disagreement arise, the fine print ("terms and conditions") on the bottom or back of the form can and often does materially alter how the disagreement is resolved - such as whether arbitration is required, the city or state where the dispute will be decided, limits on the amount or type of damages that can be recovered, etc. Indeed, the fine print can be outcome determinative. This presentation will discuss some of the more common terms and conditions that licensees, licensors, buyers and sellers need to be aware of.
